MEMORANDUM

TO: All Judges, Court Staff, Attorneys and Members of the Public
FROM: Chief Judge Robert D. Leonard II, Superior Court, Cobb Judicial Circuit
SUBJECT: Temperature Checks at Courthouse Entrances
DATE: October 28, 2021

After consultation with the Department of Public Health, I am suspending the court-ordered temperature check stations at all courthouse entrances. The Court Administrator reports that it has been quite some time since anyone was turned away for trying to enter a courthouse with a temperature. This is likely because the public and the court system have become more educated on public health matters and people know to call in advance if they are symptomatic and not come to the courthouse. Accordingly, continuing with temperature check stations is unnecessary at this time.

All staff shall continue to self-check at home before coming to work. All other requirements of previous courthouse safety guidelines and memoranda remain in effect. An updated Order will be forthcoming in the coming weeks. Thank you for your patience and vigilance during this challenging time. I would also like to extend a message of sincere appreciation to our dedicated bailiffs that dutifully manned these temperature check stations on the frontlines of the courthouse in an effort to keep the judicial campus safe.
