**REVISED SUPREME COURT POLICY REGARDING MASKS IN THE
NATHAN DEAL JUDICIAL CENTER**

Based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) **ALL** employees and visitors to the Nathan Deal Judicial Center are required to wear a well-fitting and appropriate mask covering the nose and mouth while in the common areas of the building. Each chambers and Court office will decide the extent to which masks and social distancing will be required in its common areas and personal offices, and signs will be posted to alert staff and visitors when wearing a mask and/or social distancing is required in those areas. Appropriate masks are N95 or KN95 masks or a disposable surgical mask covered by a cloth mask.

Arrival, Security Screening

- Any person who enters the building is certifying that he or she is free of COVID-19 symptoms.

The Georgia Building Authority will continue with the following measures:

- Public areas such as elevators, lobbies, and washrooms will be cleaned and frequently disinfected.
- Hand sanitizing stations will remain available for use throughout the building.
- The building contains a state-of-the art ventilation system that includes UV lighting to reduce toxins and bacteria that can enter the air stream

Operations: The Supreme Court of Georgia remains fully operational.
